Pioneer Grain Elevator

The grain elevator has three parts, two annex and a main house. One annex was built in 1956 out of wood. The second annex was built in 1963. The main house was built in 1984 out of steel. For the newest part, at least 20 people helped to build it. The elevator is approximately 200 feet wide. The main house is taller that the Shellbrook water tower.

Con Herzog (the manager) buys the grain, sells chemicals, fertilizer and gives instructions to the staff. Nobody has been hurt in the grain elevator in the last 20 years.

The grain is held in bins. The bucket elevators move the grain to the top of the elevator where it is put into trains or bins. The main control centre that controls where the grain goes is found in the main house. Trains pick up wheat, barley, canola, peas, oats and flax at the grain elevator.
